

REMINDERS FROM THE CLINIC


DUE BEFORE AUGUST 1, 2023

Students will not be permitted to attend school without the following:

- ❖ Parents of Kindergarteners and Students New to Florida Schools
 - Forms Required
 - 1. Florida Dept. of Health Immunization Card (The Diocese of Orlando does not allow religious exemptions for immunizations.)
 - 2. Physical Exam (obtained within one year of August 9, 2023)
- ❖ Parents of 7th Graders
 - Forms Required
 - 1. New Florida Dept. of Health Immunization Card completed 7th grade immunization requirements.

MEDICATIONS

- Students may not keep medications of any kind (including cough drops) in their lockers or backpacks.
- ❖ Parents may give their children medication at school as needed. However, the medication needs to be given in the clinic. This way should any untoward reaction occur, the nurse will know what medication the student has taken.
- ❖ If it is necessary for your child to take medication at school on a regular basis the clinic will need:



- an original prescription bottle /container dated within 10 days. The pharmacist will split the dose into two containers (one for school, one for home) if you ask.
- for over-the-counter medications, or medications prescribed over 10 days prior, a physician's authorization form (obtained from the clinic), is required.
- A parent <u>must</u> sign the medication into the clinic. <u>Please do not send them</u> with your child.
